
# java.net — Having the Conversation

#### Follows the Formula

#### **Outcome**

- 112,000+ members
- Over 1,500 projects, 110 JUGs
- 18 active communities
- Blogs, Wikis, RSS, lots of dialogs!
- Interesting side effects (Java Girls cafe)
- James Gosling and other key Java technology leaders participate





## The Opensolaris Community

- OSI-approved open source license (CDDL)
- 1,600 patents granted to the community
- All of Solaris OS including key innovations
  - Dynamic Tracing (DTrace), ZFS, Containers, security, etc.
- Sun (supported) Solaris OS to be based on OpenSolaris™
- Code integrated after transparent reviews
- Advisory board with five members, three external to Sun
- 102 external pilot members as of 2/10/05
- Open community with buildable source: Q2 CY 2005

## Why a New License—CDDL?



### **Common Development and Distribution License**

- Based on pioneering and popular Mozilla™ Public License—very close, but fixes logistical issues
- Royalty-free use, modification, distribution, but modifications must be shared
- Combinable with other compatible licenses
- What's new?
  - Reusable
  - Simplified notices
  - Easier to identify covered modifications
  - Choice of jurisdiction
  - Can opt out of newer versions



## **Expect the Unexpected**

- Bright, well-known people contribute code regularly
- Community finds new uses
  - Jini™ network technology and Orbitz
  - JXTA™ and National Retail Federation
- OpenOffice.org localized to 45 languages, ported to six platforms


