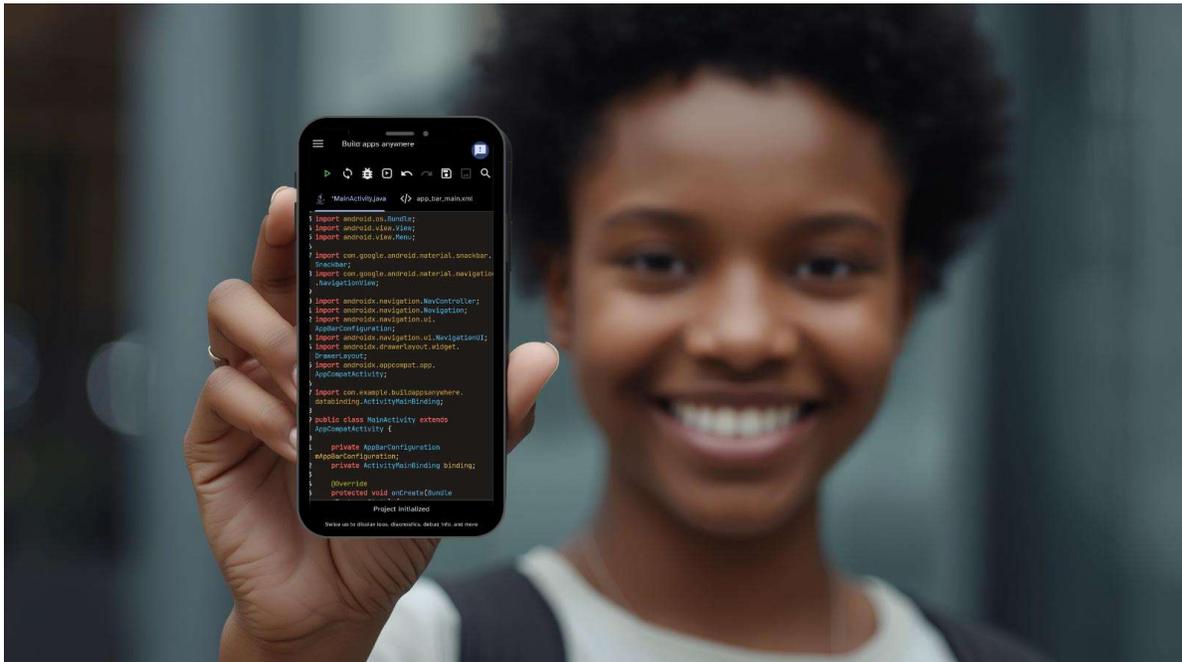

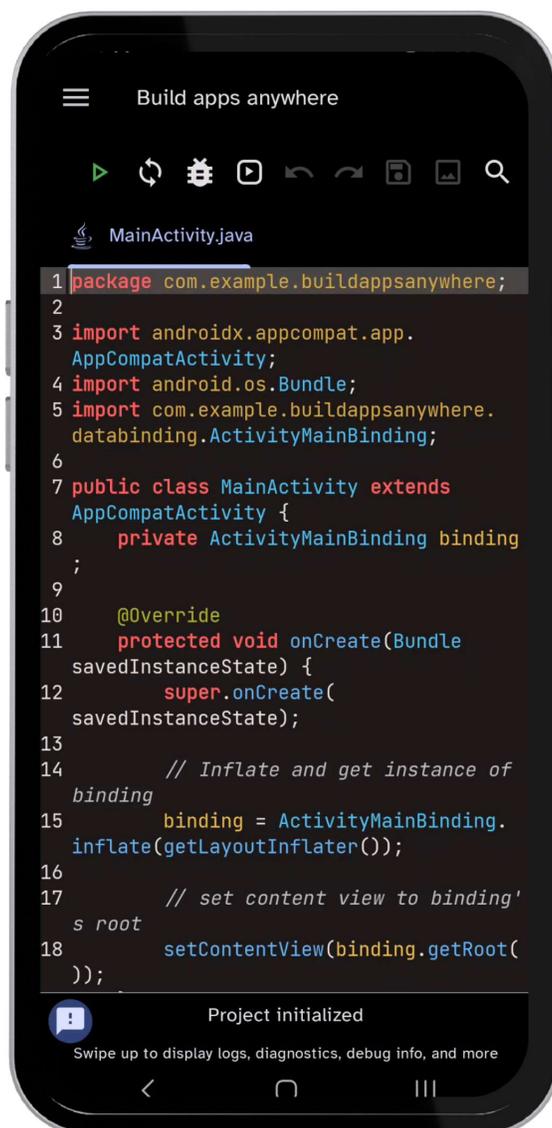

What if they could build apps with the phone that's already in their hands?



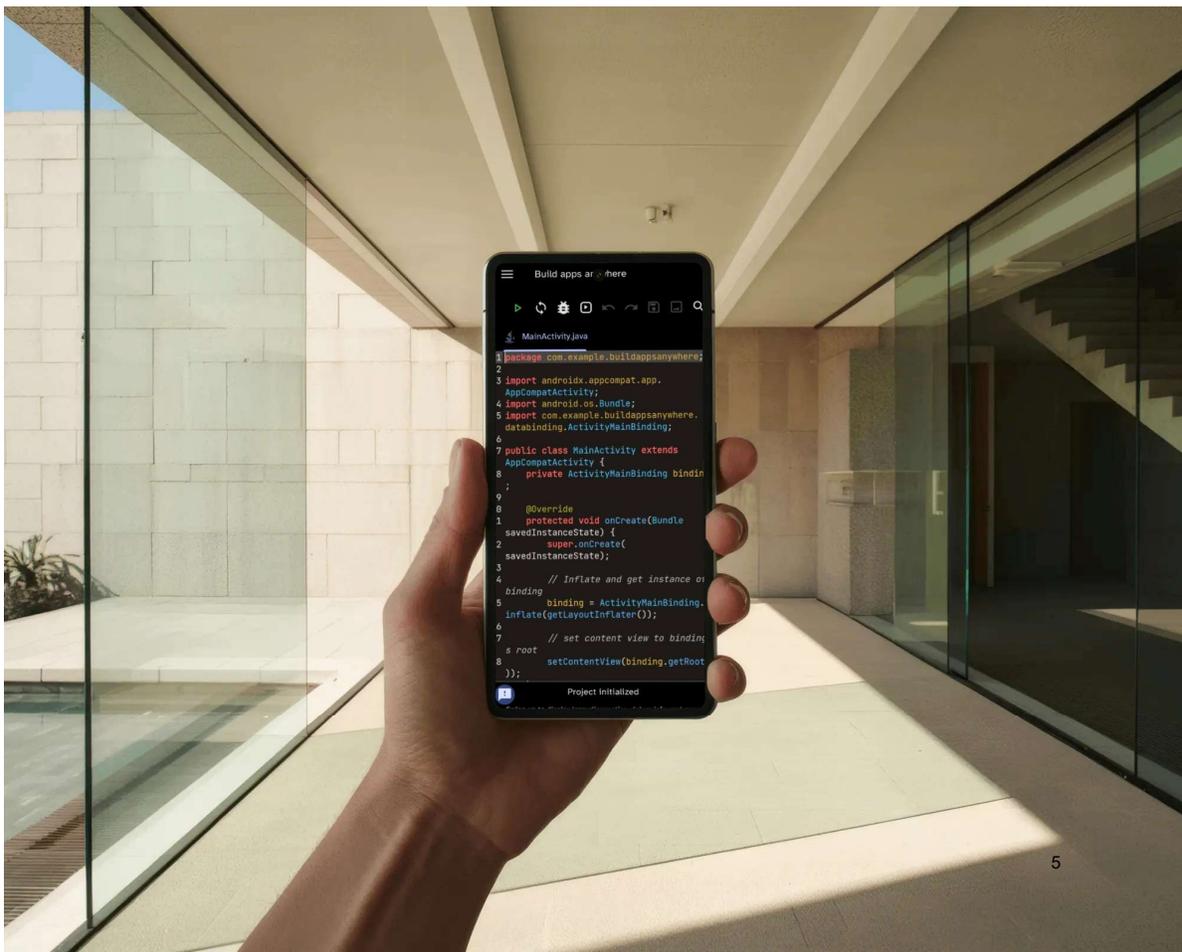


We are a nonprofit building free and open-source development tools to help bridge the digital gap and democratize access to programming resources.

Our projects include Code on the Go and Internet-in-a-Box on Android.

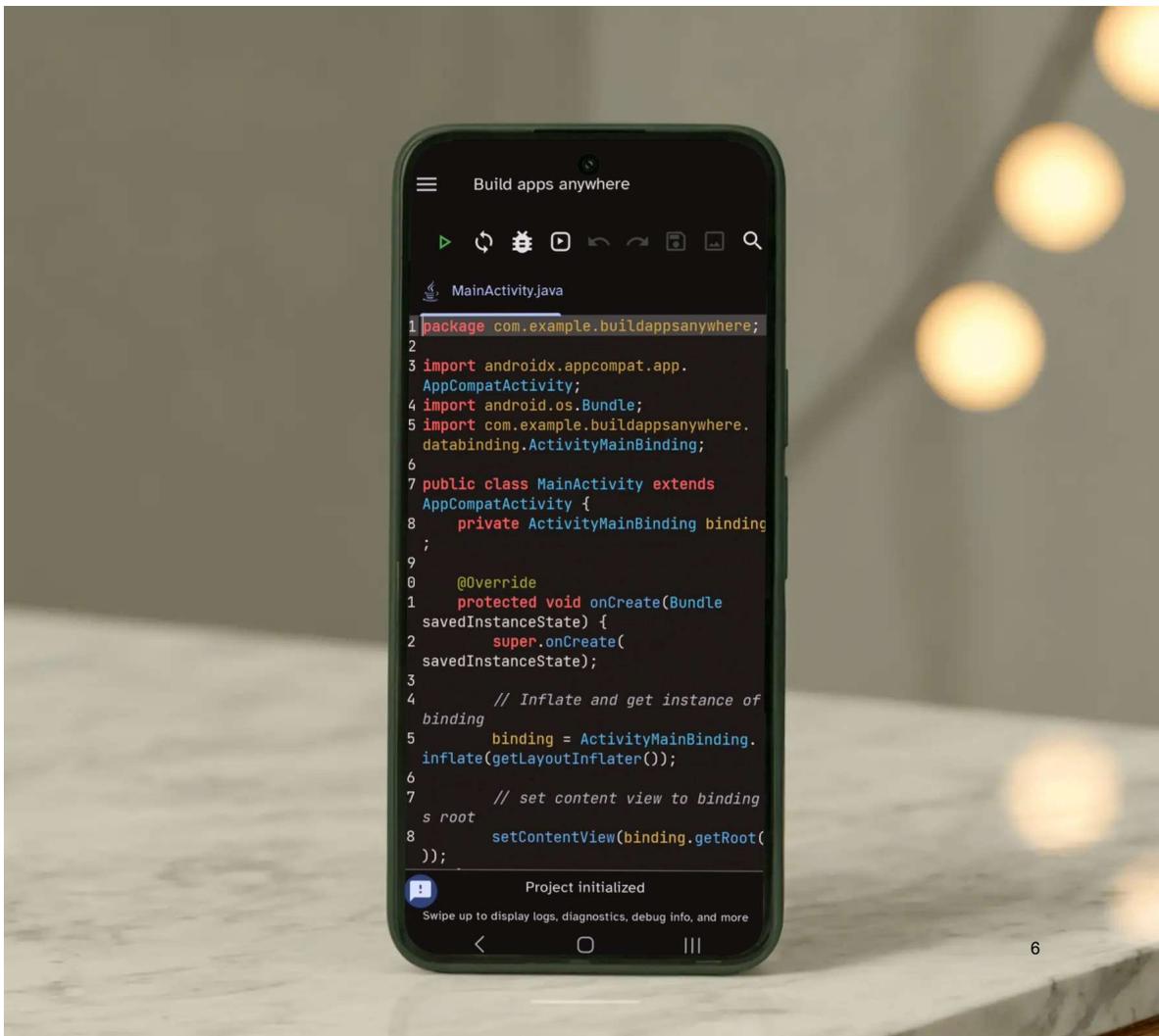
Industrial strength

- Industry-standard tools
 - Java
 - Kotlin
 - NDK for C/C++ (and even assembly language)
- On-device debugger
- Can compile and build massive capability-stretching programs



True native build system

- ARM -7 and ARM-8 toolchains
- Ports of open source toolchains
- Easy to import from other IDEs
- No emulation and transpilation
- No need to download to target



Offline first

- SDK and NDK are built in
- Internet is not needed to build apps (local Maven repositories)
- Built-in help and documentation everywhere
- Offline (and online) agentic AI



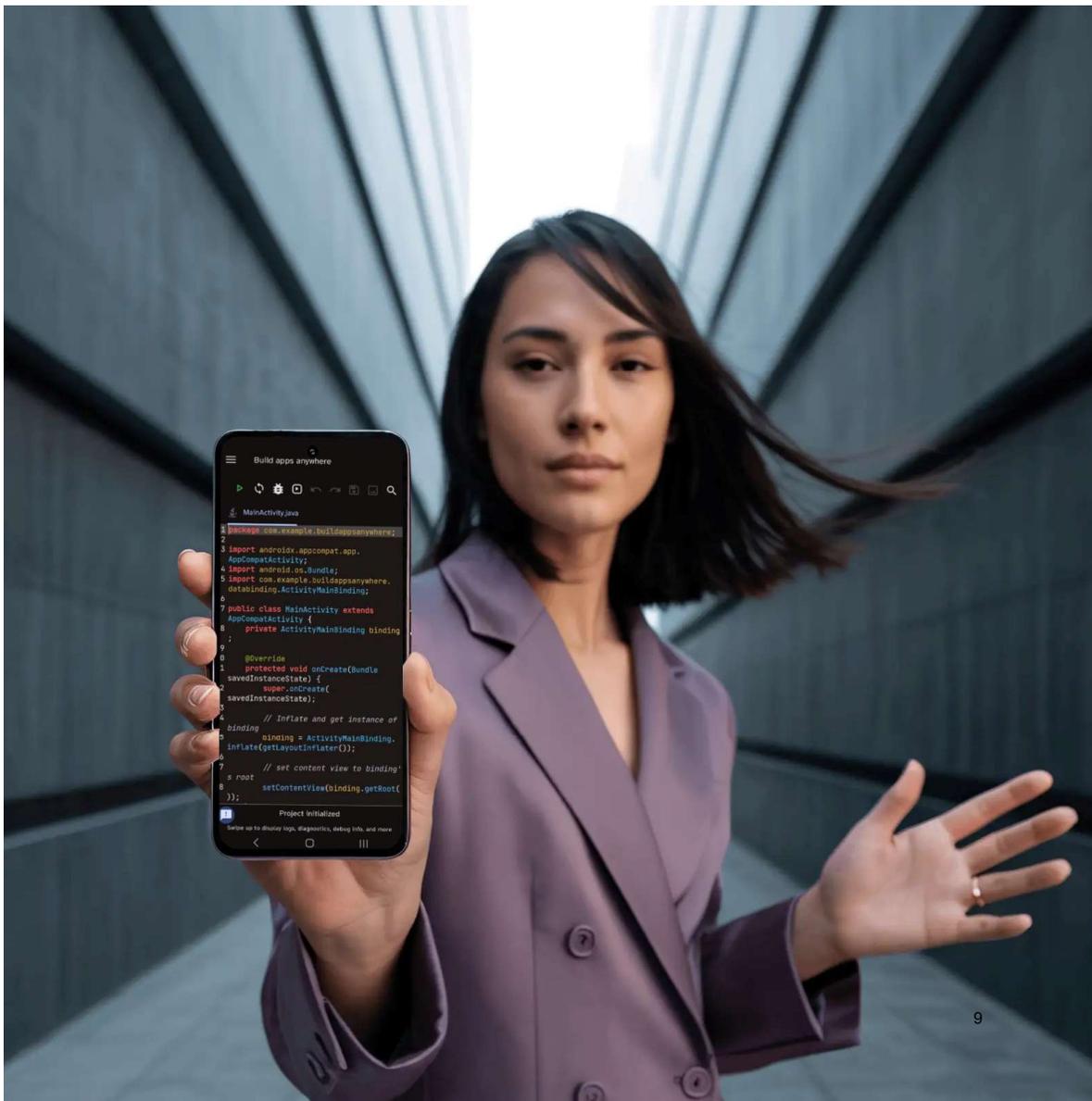
Extensible

- Robust plugin ecosystem
- Full API



Simplify development on small screens

- LSPs and shortcuts for common code actions
- Agentic AI coding support
- Sketch-to-UI converts drawings to XML layout



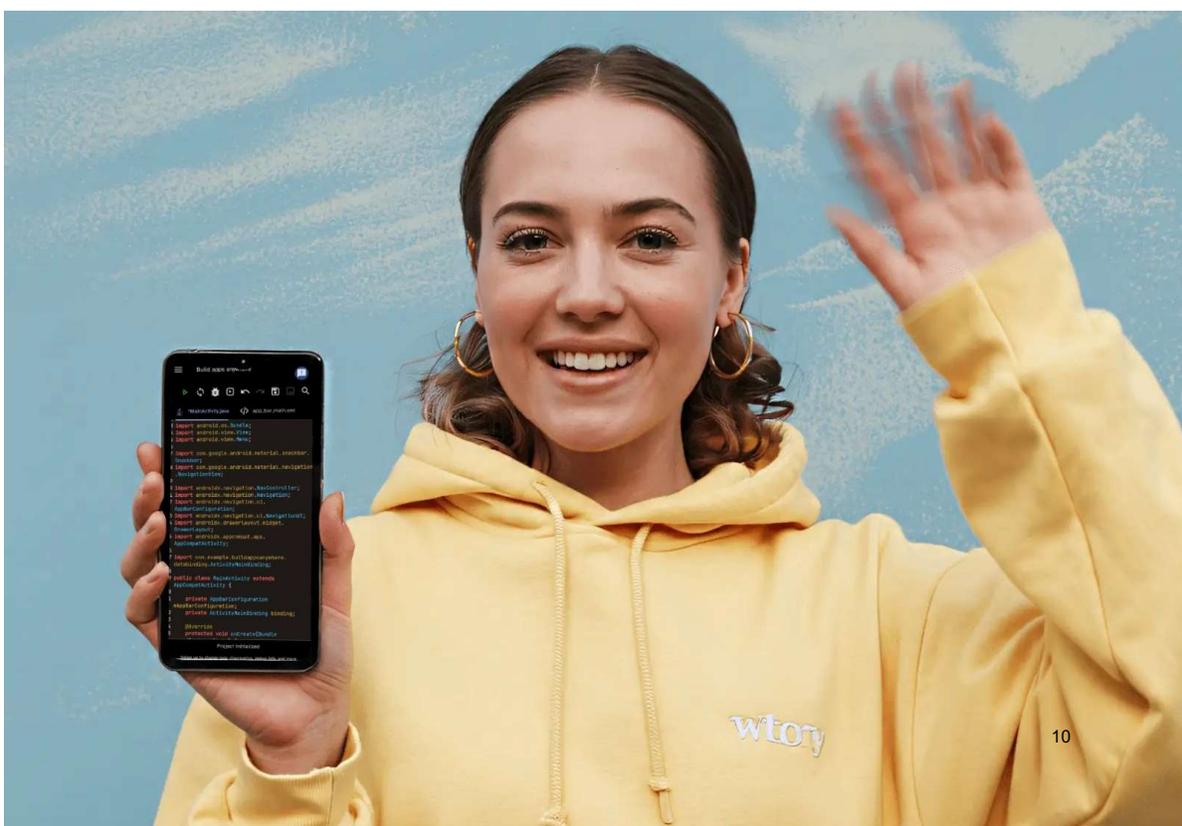
