Fleet currently uses [go-kit/log](#) for structured logging throughout the codebase. While go-kit/log has served us well, it has a fundamental limitation: it lacks native context support. The `Logger.Log(keyvals...)` interface doesn't accept a `context.Context` parameter.

Levels of confidentiality

Fleet uses these levels to standardize a commitment to minimal esotericism across the company.

- **Public:** *Share with anyone, anywhere in the world*
- **Confidential:** *Share only with team members who've signed an NDA, consulting agreement, or employment agreement*
- **Classified:** *Share only with the CEO, Head of Digital Experience, and/or the people involved. e.g., US social security numbers during hiring*
