Unique, important,
innovative, relevant,
and focused



Calls for Proposals (CFPs)

Requires advance planning
to submit proposals

Writing Titles and Abstracts

Abstract

Clear, descriptive, and detailed, but also concise



My Abstract Formula

Paragraph about why the topic is important and relevant to the conference.

The session will cover:

- Several
- Main
- Points

The audience will walk away with ...



Talk Titles

Short and clear
Matches your content

Your expertise is an important part of the selection process

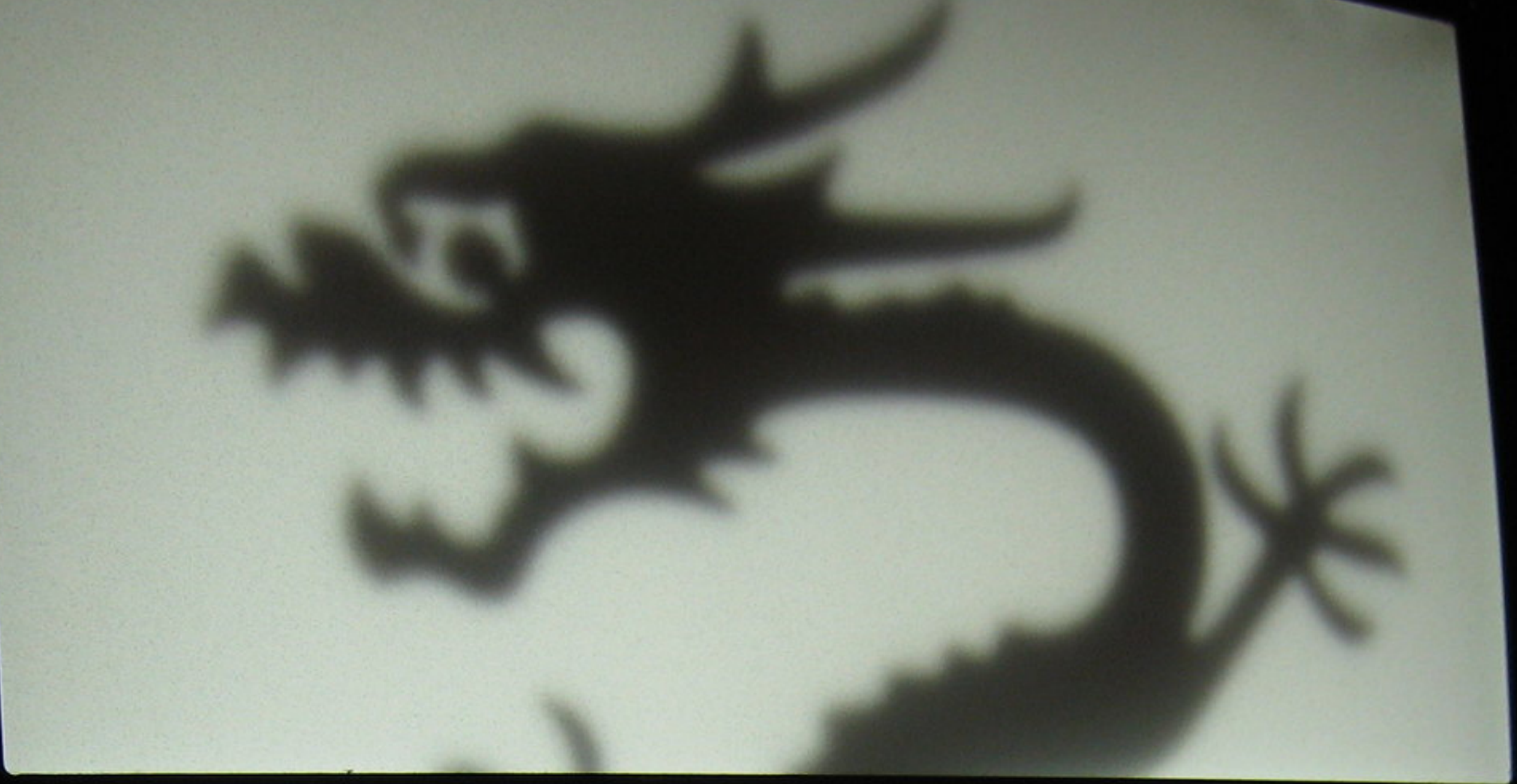

Not Enough Detail

Be clear about your content
and don't pitch a big reveal

Poorly written

Proofread and
get feedback



Don't get discouraged

You're competing against
other great proposals

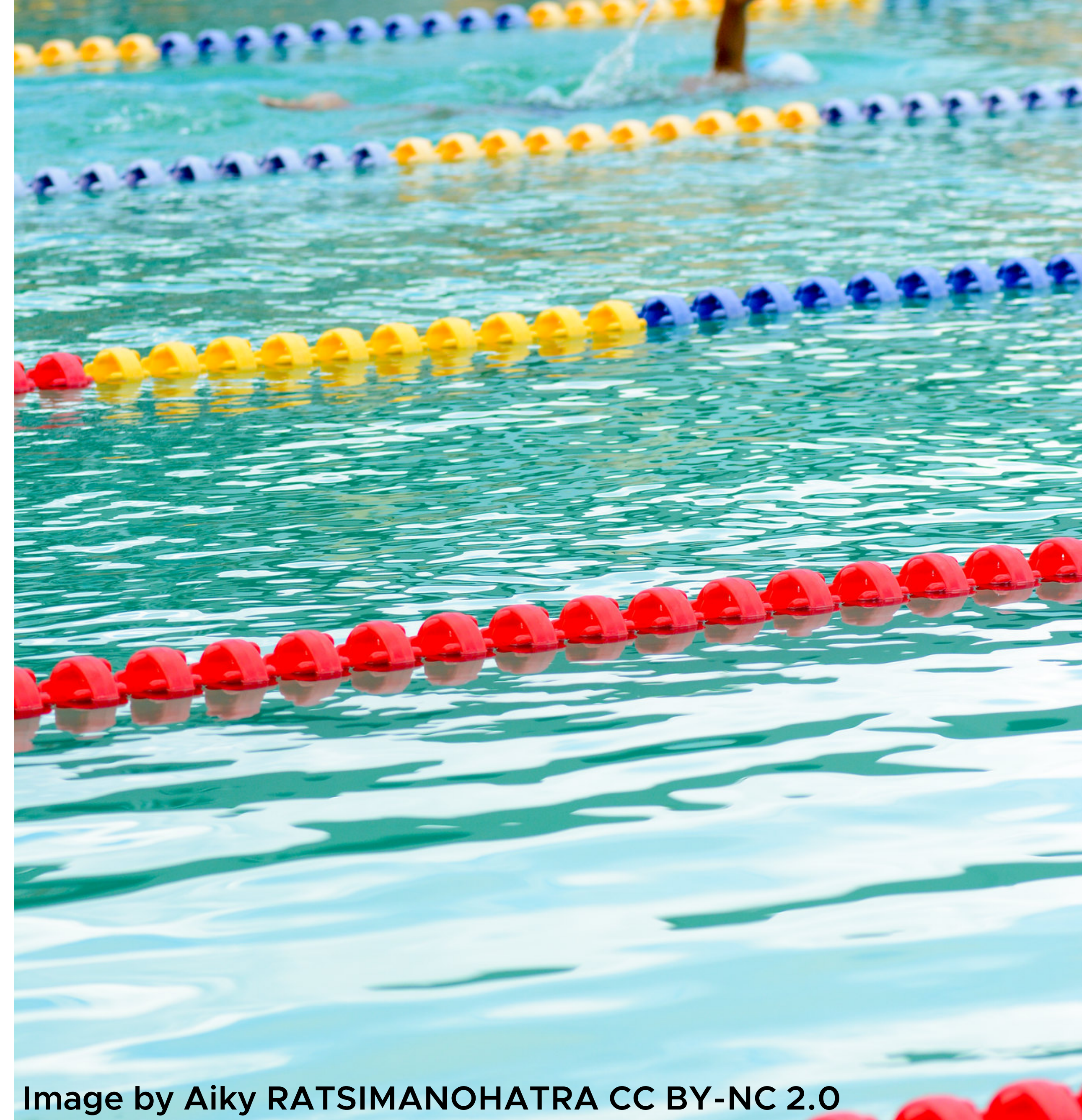

Get Organized

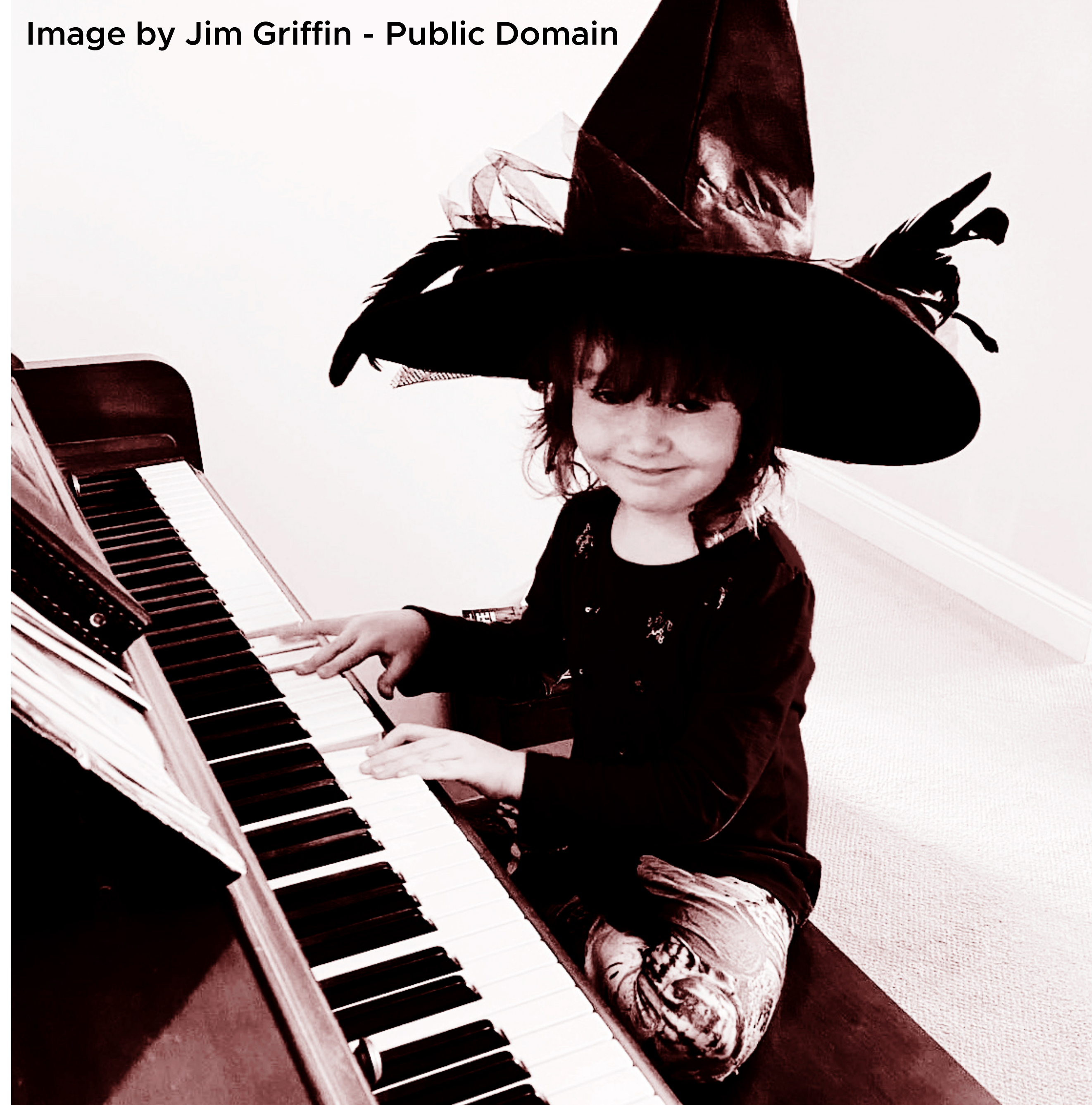
Start with an outline
and have speaker notes
